General Information

- All ages and creative abilities are encouraged to participate
- All family-friendly arts and crafts projects and fine arts are welcome
- Complete the Artist's Application when it opens
- Prepare to digitally submit .jpg images representing the work that will be for sale
- Present for the entire event (11 am - 5 pm) on Saturday, September 13, 2025
- Artists are responsible for their set-ups and take-downs
- Please pay close attention to signs indicating parking restrictions

Setup/Display of Artwork

- Bring your own tent
- Bring your own tables, chairs, and displays
- Setup begins at 9:00 am; please contact your host if you need an earlier time
- 10' x 10' grass or driveway space provided
- All display methods are acceptable if they fit within the allotted 10'x10' space.
- Tents must be secured with weights, no stakes allowed in the ground
- Visibly price your artwork
- Artwork should be family-friendly
- Complete takedown on Saturday, September 13, 2025, by 6:00 pm

Artwork

- All artwork must be original
- Please refrain from selling art based on copyrighted characters, places, or things derived from a series of characters or other aspects of that work
- Please refrain from selling/displaying art that includes profanity or is politically charged
- By participating, you take full responsibility for the safety of your art.

Fees

- There is no fee for children or students
- There is a \$50 registration fee per artist

- Tables, tents, chairs, electricity, and food will not be supplied

- Artists are responsible for collecting payment, including applicable sales tax, on all sales during Art Crawl and must fulfill reporting requirements for the Minnesota Department of Revenue
